Statement of the First Emergency Conference of the Chin National Front

The first Emergency Conference of the Chin National Front was convened from December 12-16, 2011, at Indo-Burma border, and it was attended by representatives of the Chin National Front and the Chin National Army, advisors, experts, special invitees, university students, and observers, totaling 153 in number.

The Conference had discussions, and decisions were made regarding how to get all tribes, all regions, and all levels of the Chin society integrated so that they could participate steadfastly in the national revolution by means of armed resistance or by all other possible means to achieve the objectives of the Chin National Front which include re-attaining Self-determination, establishing a Federal Union, and for propagation of democratic rule.

The Conference further discussed how to strengthen and stabilize the Chin National Front and the Chin National Army, the up-coming preliminary State level peace talk between the Chin State Government and the Chin National Front to create peace in the country, reviewed the organization and leadership structure of the Chin National Front, and elected leaders for the 5th Party Conference term.

The representatives of the Emergency Conference unanimously confirmed their support to the resolution made by the Central Committee of the 4th Conference term to have a preliminary State level peace talk between Chin State Government and the Chin National Front on January 5-6, 2012 in Halkha. The Conference demands holding a Union level political dialogue between the Government and the Ethnic nationalities to establish a lasting peace in the country.

The Emergency Conference formed a Central Committee with 55 members in its reformation of the organizational structure of the Chin National Front to have all tribes, all regions, and all classes of the Chin society involved in the national revolution. Out of those elected for the Central Committee, 14 were elected for the Central Executive Committee and another 21 members to form a Supreme Council of the Chin National Front, which shall oversee the implementing works of the Central Executive Committee.

The Emergency Conference elected Dr. Za Hlei Thang rotating Chairman of the Supreme Council of the Chin National Front for the first year, Pu Lian Uk the second year, Salai Kipp Kho Lian the third year and Pu Thang Nang Lian Thang the fourth year as they will take chairmanship in rotation in the upcoming Conference term.

It is hereby announced that the Conference elected Pu Zing Cung the Secretary-General, Pu Paul Sitha, Dr. Sui Khar, and Pu Khua Uk Lian Assistant Secretaries-General, and 47 members of the Central Committee for the forthcoming Conference term.
